# **Ladies Live-Fire Small Group Handgun Draw - Shoot - Clear Ladies Only Student Information Sheet**

Dear Student,

Thank you for choosing Montana Tactical Firearms Instruction, Inc. (MTFI) for your firearms safety training. Please read this document completely prior to class.

**Course Fee: Part 1 is \$125 per student. Part 2 is \$125 per student.**

**Course Times: Part 1 - 10am to 12pm Part 2 - 1pm to 4pm**

**Classroom Location & Gun Range:**

MTFI Regional Training Center ~112 West Farm Road, Three Forks, MT.

***Directions to the Training Center are located on Page 4 of this document.***

**MTFI Refund Policy:** If you are unable to attend the course date you had signed up for, your deposit may be applied to another instruction date or course, but must be redeemed within **six (6)** months of the course date you originally planned to attend. **There are no refunds** for courses that you could not attend; however, if the course is cancelled by MTFI, then you will be refunded in full.

**Course Description:** This course is designed for newer shooters and picks up where the basic handgun course left off.

**Part 1** is a dry fire course only. There is no live-fire training during this course. During this course students will learn how to draw from your holster safely, acquire proper sight alignment, proper grip and learn to recognize and clear handgun malfunctions.

**Part 2** is a live-fire course on the gun range. During this course students will perform live-fire shooting drills with purpose, practice safe clearing malfunctions of their handguns and shoot with accuracy. **Prerequisite:** you must have taken either the MTFI G&G 1.0 or the Basic Handgun Safety Course in order to attend Part 2.

**Firearm Rental Fee is \$40:** If you do not own a firearm you can rent one from MTFI for the day. Please let us know so that a firearm can be reserved for you. Students are responsible for the ammunition needed for range qualification.

**Firearms In the Training Center:** If you own your own firearm, please bring it to train with! ***Please do not bring loaded handguns or ammunition into the classroom.*** If you cannot store it in your vehicle, please present it to an MTFI Instructor for safe storage.

### **What to Bring For Part 1:**

- Handgun (no ammunition needed) Hip
- holster which is secured by a belt
- Magazine pouch
- Three (3) magazines
- Dummy rounds which can be purchased at MTFI

### **What to Bring For Part 2:**

- Handgun (no ammunition in the classroom) Hip
- holster which is secured by a belt
- SERPA Holsters** are not allowed on the gun range
- Magazine pouch
- Three (3) magazines for double-stack type magazines Six
- (6) magazines for single-stack type magazines 200
- Rounds of practice ammunition
- Bring or wear clothes that will be suitable for whatever weather may occur; rain, snow or hot sun. Long pants are recommended. We will shoot regardless of weather conditions, so please plan accordingly!
- Eye and ear protection must be worn by everyone on the gun range. Sunglasses or prescription glasses are fine for eye protection. Ear plugs and glasses are available on site.
- Sturdy closed toe boots or hiking shoes. Do not wear flip-flops, sandals or Birkenstock type shoes.
- **A Special Safety Note To Ladies:** We have found that loose fitting and low neck blouses will allow for hot spent casings to be caught there. Though no long term injury will occur, the hot brass cartridge casing will cause a few seconds of pain on a sensitive area of your body. Therefore, we recommend that you wear something which will protect your neck and chest area from hot spent casings.

**Snakes:** Encounters with poisonous and dangerous rattlesnakes are a real possibility during warm weather. Please be aware of your surroundings. If you

encounter a rattle snake, calmly advise MTFI Staff and others in close proximity so that this concern may be addressed safely.

## Directions to the MTFI Regional Training Center

- Do not use Google Maps to find the Training Center, as it will send you to several wrong locations.
- Traveling east or west on US I 90, take **Exit 274**.
- You will see the **Exxon Town Pump** truck stop just south of the overpass and a street sign for “**West Farm Road.**”
- Turn right onto West Farm Road and travel for 1 mile to the MTFI Regional Training Center.
