# MTFI Montana Concealed Carry and Basic Handgun (Co-Ed) Student Information Sheet

Welcome! Thank you for choosing Montana Tactical Firearms Instruction, Inc. (MTFI) for your firearms safety training. Please read this document completely prior to class.

Open to the Public Co-ed Course Fee: \$190 per student

Course Times: 10am until 6pm (+/-)

#### **Classroom Location & Gun Range:**

MTFI Regional Training Center ~112 West Farm Road, Three Forks, MT Directions to the Training Center are located on Page 4 of this document.

MTFI Refund Policy: If you are unable to attend the course date you had signed up for, your deposit may be applied to another instruction date or course, but must be redeemed within six (6) months of the course date you originally planned to attend. There are no refunds for courses that you could not attend; however, if the course is cancelled by MTFI, then you will be refunded in full.

**Replacement Training Certificates:** If you lose your certificate, the replacement cost is \$40.

**Free Course For Alumni:** Once you have successfully completed this course, you may attend the course again as many times as you like *at no cost, forever*. Just notify us prior to the date you would like to attend to insure there will be room for you.

<u>Course Description</u>: Our course has been approved by Montana State as a Certified Firearms Safety Course, and will qualify participants to apply for their Montana State Concealed Weapons Permit (CWP) if desired.

This course is great for those with little to no experience with handguns. Topics covered will range from: picking the best handgun and accessories for you and your particular needs, handgun safety with revolvers and semiautomatic handguns, nomenclature and operation, handgun malfunctions and clearing methods, understanding types of ammunition and how they function or

malfunction, fundamentals of shooting, sight alignment and sights picture, how to effectively stop a threat, cleaning and maintenance. There will be a live-fire range qualification one-on-one with an instructor.

<u>Our Facility</u>: We have full- sized classrooms, a kitchen, clean restrooms, and a covered/protected portion of the building, which has stand-alone heaters for cold days (we shoot no matter the weather) which is attached to our shooting range.

MTFI Basic Pistol Shooting Certificates of Completion: The Montana State CWP is currently recognized in 32 other states nationwide. The certificate of completion will be provided at the end of the training day to students who successfully complete the course.

"Introduction to Montana State Gun Laws" We will email or mail this document to you. Prior to attending the course, please read and answer the questions incorporated within it. Bring a copy of this document with you so that we can go over it in class.

**Firearm Rental Fee:** For those who are trying to find out which firearm is "right for you", we will have <u>many</u> handguns available to rent and shoot for a single **\$20 fee**. Ammunition is a separate cost and is available onsite for purchase.

**30 to 45 Minute Lunch Break:** We suggest that you bring your lunch with you, as food served in this area can be a bit slow. We have a full kitchen available for your convenience.

**Firearms In the Training Center:** If you own your own firearm, please bring it to train with! *Please do not bring loaded handguns or ammunition into the classroom.* If you cannot store it in your vehicle, please present it to an MTFI Instructor for safe storage.

#### What to Bring For the Live-Fire Range Time:

- **ATTENTION:** Due to safety concerns involving the Sig Suaer P320 firing without activating the trigger, reported injuries and deaths involving its use; we have determined that until further notice this handgun will not be allowed to be used for training at our facility.
- **Please Note:** SERPA Type Holsters are not allowed on the gun range.
- 50 Rounds of practice ammunition.
- Long pants are highly recommended.
- Sturdy closed toe boots or hiking shoes.
- Bring or wear clothes that will be suitable for whatever weather may occur; rain, snow or hot sun. Long pants are recommended. We will shoot regardless of weather conditions, so please plan accordingly!

- Eye and ear protection must be worn by everyone on the gun range. Sunglasses or prescription classes are fine for eye protection. Ear plugs and glasses are available on site.
- Sturdy closed toe boots or hiking shoes. Do not wear flip-flops sandals or Birkenstock type shoes.
- A Special Safety Note To Ladies: We have found that loose fitting and low neck blouses will allow for hot spent casings to be caught there. Though no long term injury will occur, the hot brass cartridge casing will cause a few seconds of pain on a sensitive area of your body. Therefore, we recommend that you wear something which will protect your neck and chest area from hot spent casings.

<u>Snakes</u>: Encounters with poisonous and dangerous rattlesnakes are a real possibility during warm weather. Please be aware of your surroundings. If you encounter a rattlesnake, calmly advise MTFI Staff and others in close proximity so that this concern may be addressed safely.
