Shotgun Course Description:

During this course you will receive instruction on shotgun safety, shotgun familiarization and use, how to load and reload safely, combat loading techniques, staging the shotgun for personal defense in a home or automobile, field stripping, cleaning and maintenance, understanding the types of ammunition available for personal defense, accuracy while shooting, live-fire range drills and clay pigeon shooting.

The MTFI Staff:

You will receive instruction from our friendly, patient trained National Rifle Association Certified Firearms Instructors, Montana State Licensed Firearms Instructors and USCCA Firearms Instructors. Three of our instructors are retired law enforcement officers with a wide range of field experiences and practical use and insight. Our instructors will help you increase your confidence with your shotgun, understand firearm safety rules, how it operates, what its capabilities are and become confident with a new skill.

What Type of Shotgun Should You Bring?

The shotgun you currently own and intend to use for recreation or personal defense. It does not have to be a "tactical shotgun." If you do not own a shotgun, you can rent one from MTFI for \$50. The cost of ammunition is separate.

Let Us Know What Shotgun You Are Planning to Train With:

Please email me and let me know which brand, model and caliber shotgun you are planning to train with.

MTFI Refund Policy: If you are unable to attend the course date you had signed up for, your deposit may be applied to another instruction date or course, but must be redeemed within **six (6)** months of the course date you originally planned to attend. **There are no refunds** for courses that you could not attend; however, if the course is cancelled by MTFI, then you will be refunded in full.

Ammunition Load-Out:

Due to the difficulty of finding ammunition, we have lowered our round count for this course.

- 8 boxes of light bird shot (7 1/2 or 8). They come in 25 rounds per
- box. 4 boxes of OO Buck. They come in five rounds per box.
- 2 boxes of shotgun rifle slugs per student. They come 5 rounds per box.

Short Lunch Break:

We suggest that you bring a lunch with you to eat in the classroom in order to save time. We have a full kitchen in the event you would like to prepare your meal here.

What to Bring to the Classroom:

- Your unloaded shotgun.
- Do not bring ammunition into the classroom. If you cannot store the ammunition in your vehicle, please present it to an MTFI Instructor for safe storage.
- Dummy rounds are required for this course. Dummy rounds can be purchased from MTFI or a local firearms retail store.
- Four (4) 1 gallon jugs of water.
- Wear clothes that will be suitable for whatever weather may occur; rain, snow or hot sun. Regardless of weather conditions, we will shoot!
- Sturdy closed toe boots or hiking shoes. Do not wear flip-flops or Birkenstock type shoes. Eye and ear protection - Ear and eye protection must be worn while shooting. Prescription glasses or sunglasses suffice for eye protection.

Snakes:

Encounters with poisonous and dangerous rattlesnakes are a real possibility during warm weather. Please be aware of your surroundings. If you encounter a rattlesnake, calmly advise MTFI Staff so that it can be dealt with safely.
