MTFI Refund Policy: If you are unable to attend the course date you had signed up for, your deposit may be applied to another instruction date or course, but must be redeemed within **six (6)** months of the course date you originally planned to attend. **There are no refunds** for courses that you could not attend; however, if the course is cancelled by MTFI, then you will be refunded in full.

Free Course For Alumni: Once you have successfully completed this course, you may attend the course again as many times as you like **at no cost, forever**. Just notify us prior to the date you would like to attend to insure there will be room for you.

Our Facility: Our modern facility is air conditioned with two full sized classrooms each with big screen televisions for PowerPoint presentations. We have a full kitchen, clean restrooms, and a wood stove for the winter months. For the shooting range, we have an outdoor range and a covered/protected portion of the building. This area has stand-alone heaters for cold days (we shoot no matter the weather).

30 to 45 Minute Lunch Break: We suggest that you bring your lunch with you, as food served in this area can be a bit slow. We have a full kitchen available for your convenience.

More about the Course:

The Montana Concealed Carry/Basic Handgun Course for Ladies is a seven (7) hour Handgun Safety Shooting Course designed to create opportunities for women of all ages to learn about firearm selection, safety and proper use.

Here is what you can expect:

- You will receive instruction from our friendly, patient National Rifle Association Certified Instructors, Montana State Licensed Firearms Instructors, and USCCA Instructors. Our instructors will help you increase your confidence with your firearm, understand firearm safety rules, become confident with your new skills, and provide you the opportunity of becoming effective and efficient with your firearm. Each class has multiple instructors who can provide one-on-one shooting instruction!
- Our course is approved by Montana State as a Certified Firearms Safety Course. As such, this course will qualify participants to apply for their Montana State Concealed Weapons Permit (CWP) through their local law enforcement agency of jurisdiction. The Montana State CWP is currently recognized in 32 other states nationwide! At the successful conclusion of this course, a certificate of completion will be issued to you immediately.
- **Replacement Certificate Policy:** If you lose the MTFI certificate, the replacement cost is \$40.00.
- **Firearms In the Training Center:** If you own your own firearm, please bring it to train with! ***Please do not bring loaded handguns or ammunition into the classroom.*** If you cannot store it in your vehicle, please present it to an MTFI Instructor for safe storage.
- **Rental of Firearms:** For those who are trying to find out which firearm is “right for you”, we will have many handguns available to rent and shoot for a single **\$20 fee**. Ammunition is a separate cost and is available onsite for purchase.

“Introduction to Montana State Gun Laws” We will email this document to you. Prior to attending the course, please read this document so that you are familiar with it, and bring a copy to class so we can go over it together.

What to Bring For the Live-Fire Range Time:

- **ATTENTION:** Due to safety concerns involving the Sig Sauer P320 firing without activating the trigger, reported injuries and deaths involving its use;

we have determined that until further notice this handgun will not be allowed to be used for training at our facility.

- **Please Note: SERPA TYPE Holsters** are not allowed on the gun range.
- 50 Rounds of practice ammunition.
- Long pants are highly recommended.
- Sturdy closed toe boots or hiking shoes.
- Bring or wear clothes that will be suitable for whatever weather may occur; rain, snow or hot sun. Long pants are recommended. We will shoot regardless of weather conditions, so please plan accordingly!
- Eye and ear protection must be worn by everyone on the gun range. Sunglasses or prescription glasses are fine for eye protection. Ear plugs and glasses are available on site.
- Sturdy closed toe boots or hiking shoes. Do not wear flip-flops sandals or Birkenstock type shoes.
- **A Special Safety Note To Ladies:** We have found that loose fitting or low neck blouses will allow for hot spent casings to be caught in your blouse. Though no long term injury will occur, the hot brass cartridge casing will cause a few seconds of pain on a sensitive area of the body. Therefore, we recommend that you wear something which will protect your neck and chest area from hot spent casings.

Snakes: Encounters with poisonous and dangerous rattlesnakes are a real possibility during warm weather. If you encounter a rattlesnake, calmly advise MTFI Staff so that it may be addressed safely.
